

# Rib on Rib knitted Cowl



**Description:** soft, easy care, reversible cowl in a stretchy stitch pattern

**Skill:** Beginner – advanced Beginner

**Size** – 19”; can be made larger or smaller by increasing or decreasing the number of stitches cast on

**Materials:**

1 skein Cascade Nifty Cotton Splash, 100% cotton; sample in photo is color#207, “Blue N Green”

US 7 circular needle; 16”

Stitch marker

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Gauge: 20 stitches x 20 rows in rib patter

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Cast on 110 stitches, join in the round being careful to not twist the stitches

Round 1 – 4: Knit

Round 5: \*K1 through the back loop, P1, repeat from \* to the end of the round

Repeat Round 5 until work measures 5” from the rolled edge, or to desired height.

Final Rounds: repeat Rounds 1 – 4

Bind off loosely, Weave in ends.

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
